

# «You have one teacher and you are all students»

## **SEARCHING FOR THE TRUTH**

With her first companions, she started to read the Gospel. They found that its words are «unique, eternal, fascinating». They are not something from the past, like the words of an important person in history, but they are words that Jesus directs to me, to us, to every person of every time and place.

### IS JESUS REALLY OUR TEACHER?

Many people, even great teachers, propose to us ideas and ways of life. Famous poets, philosophers and politicians often say very good things to inspire us. #### SHARING EXPERIENCES

We should read the Word of Life together because Jesus himself lives in the midst of those who are gathered in his name and who will suggest to us how to live it. Then we can share our experiences of living it. Chiara says that when they started to live the Gospel, «we felt the duty of communicating to the others what we had experienced. We knew that if we gave the experience it would remain in us, and would increase our interior life, whereas if we didn't give it, our soul would gradually shrivel up. Therefore, we lived the word every moment of the day and shared the experiences, not only among ourselves, but with everyone else who joined that first group. (...) When we lived it, it was no longer I who lived, nor «we», but rather the Word lived in me, the Word lived in the group. It was the Christian revolution in action, with all the consequences that come from it».
