"The greatest among you will be your servant."

(Mt 23:11)

What is the best way to serve?

To answer this, Chiara Lubich shared her own personal experience:

"We have to fix our gaze on the one Father of many children. Then look at all people as sons and daughters of that one Father...

Jesus is our model in doing this and he taught us two things which are actually just one: Be children of one Father and be brothers and sisters to one another.

God calls us to aim at making the whole world one family."

WHAT'S NEW

Love everyone as Jesus did, because everyone is a child of God, just like you, just like me. God loves each and every person on earth and always waits for them to come to him. We will discover that every person we meet during the day is someone to be loved in concrete ways, even using our physical strength - our muscles!

SHARE

"Make ourselves one" with each person we meet, feeling what they are feeling in that moment. Help them resolve any problem they have as if it were our own. In fact, it is ours if we love them! So we shouldn't think only of ourselves, but try to share their joys and listen to their doubts and difficulties.
