Jesus said these words just before his passion and death. In fact, these words were part of his farewell to his disciples, part of his last will and testament. **So it's obvious how important they are!** If the words a father pronounces on his deathbed can never be forgotten, how should we feel about the words of God? **Let's take them seriously, and together try to understand them in depth.**

We know that **Jesus is present** in the sacraments. **In the Mass, for instance, he becomes truly present in the Eucharist.** But Jesus is also present **wherever there is mutual love.** Indeed, he said, "Where two or three are gathered in my name, (and this is possible when we love one another) I am there among them" (Mt. 18:20). **In a community where people are deeply rooted in mutual love, therefore, he will be present and active.**

So if you want to discover the true mark of authentic Christians, **if you want to see their badge, you have to look for it in the mutual love they live.** Christians are recognized by this sign, and **if it's missing, the world will no longer be able to find Jesus in the Church.**
