Jean Luis was a young man «of little faith». Even though he was a Christian, he doubted the existence of God, unlike the other members of his family.

He was living in the city of Man, in the Ivory Coast, with his younger brothers and sisters, far away from their parents.

During the civil war, four rebels broke into their house and took everything they had, even forcing Jean Luis to go with them to be a soldier, since they saw that he was a strong young man.

His younger brothers begged the men to leave him alone, but it was no use. They were dragging him out when all of a sudden their leader changed his mind and let him go.

The leader whispered in the ear of his oldest sister: «Get away from here as fast as you can, because tomorrow we'll be back…». And he even showed them what path they should take. They asked one another: «Is that really the right way to go or is this a trap?»
