(Heb 10:9)

This sentence tells us the secret of Jesus' life. It helps us to see the GOLDEN THREAD that linked all the stages of his earthly life, starting with his life in Nazareth, then the temptations by the devil, then his preaching and miracles, and finally his death on the cross.

In every moment, in every situation, Jesus tried to do just one thing:

To fulfill the will of his Father, who is Love.

The most important thing in life is to do God's will and not our own. We have to learn to say no to ourselves and say yes to him.

Real love for God does not consist in nice words, or good feelings, but in obeying his commandments.

This is one of the Words of the Gospel that shows us that we have to go against the current of the world, because it is a natural tendency to do what we want, to follow our own instincts and desires. Instead we have to do what God wants for us.
