“I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another.

(Jn 13:34)

When did Jesus say these words?

It was on the night before he died. He was speaking to his disciples for the last time and gave them his final message. So you can see how important these words are! We never forget the last words of our father just before he dies, so how can we forget these words of Jesus who is God and was giving up his life for us? **But how will he remain with us?**

He told us:

«For where two or three are gathered in my name (which means loving one another), there am I among them» (Mt 18:20).

**Therefore, in a community that bases its whole life on mutual love, he can be present and continue to reveal himself to us and have an impact on the world.**

**Isn't that great? Don't you want to start right now to love like this?**



Right after this, Jesus told them:

«By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another» (Jn 13:35).

**The uniform of true disciples of Jesus is mutual love which leads to unity.**

Jesus wants to tell you what should be the basis of your whole life. **Before working, before studying, before any activity, be sure that you are living mutual love with others.**
