
Steps we need to take in order to think like Jesus.

A CONCRETE ACT OF LOVE I DID:



Another way to think and feel like Jesus is to be ENRICHED BY THE GOOD AND POSITIVE QUALITIES IN THE PEOPLE WE MEET, avoiding any judgements of them or their behavior. Even though it might be hard sometimes to find anything good in another person, we won't get discouraged.
