«To forgive another person means opening a door for that person to establish a new relationship with you.

> It gives them, and you too, the chance to START ALL OVER AGAIN

and to ensure that, in the future, evil will never win out».

We follow Jesus and when he was on the cross, he asked his Father to forgive those who were killing him – and then he rose from the dead!»

«How does God forgive? First of all, God forgives all the time! He never gets tired of forgiving.
We are the ones who get tired of asking him to forgive us. But he never gets tired of forgiving».
