This month we present the experience of Cardinal François van Thuân, who was from Vietnam and spent 13 years in prison, 9 of which were in solitary confinement. He gave witness to the truth that when love is sincere and without any self-interest, others respond with love, too.



When he was in prison, he had five guards, but every two weeks the directors of the prison had to change them for another group of five because they would get «contaminated» by the love of the bishop.

They finally decided to leave the same guards all the time because otherwise he would have converted all the police in the prison!



«At first the guards would not speak to me. They only answered yes or no. One night I got an idea.
I told myself, "François, you are still very rich because you have the love of Jesus in your heart. Love them like Jesus loved you!"

The next morning I started to love them even more than before, seeing Jesus in each one, smiling at them and speaking kindly to them».
