**MUTUAL LOVE:** 

MUTUAL LOVE IS LIKE A DEBT WE OWE TO OTHERS. WE HAVE TO BE GENEROUS, SINCERE, ATTENTIVE TO THEIR NEEDS, AND GIVE THEM OUR TRUST AND ESTEEM. A DEBT MUST BE PAID, WE CANNOT PUT IT OFF OR IGNORE IT. IT URGES US ON, AND IMPELS US. IT WILL NOT LEAVE US IN PEACE UNTIL WE PAY IT.

ANOTHER HAS FULFILLED THE LAW.»

KEEP MUTUAL LOVE IN MIND. IT'S THE GOAL GOD WANTS US TO REACH BY LIVING THE COMMANDMENTS.
